



SUPPLEMENTAL CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Venice Blvd Street Improvements

ATTENTION RESIDENTS AND BUSINESS OWNERS

As part of the construction of Phase 2 of the Expo Light Rail Line, work crews will implement lane and street closures to complete roadway improvements on Venice Blvd in the City of Los Angeles. The work is being managed and performed by the Expo Phase 2 design-build contractor *Skanska-Rados, Joint Venture (SRJV)*.

Continuous Weekend Closure of Curts Ave and Ivy Street at Venice Blvd. <i>(The right lane on Westbound Venice Blvd between National Blvd and Vera Ave will be closed during this period)</i>	24-Hour Work Shifts	9:00 a.m., Friday, January 9 - 6:00 a.m., Monday, January 12 <i>Pending weather conditions</i>

Traffic Impacts:

- **Closure of northbound Robertson Blvd:**
 - Local access to Northbound Robertson Blvd will be maintained via Ellis Ave and National Blvd. Please follow detour signs to loop around via Robertson Place to Exposition Blvd.
 - Eastbound I-10 Freeway Robertson Blvd Off-Ramp will be closed. Traffic will be detoured to the La Cienega freeway exit.
- Additional intermittent nighttime lane closures will be implemented throughout construction.
- Pedestrian access for the north side will be maintained at all times either via a designated pedestrian walkway or detour.

Advisories:

- Directional signage and/or flaggers will be used to safely direct vehicles and pedestrians around the construction zone.
- Temporary parking restrictions will be required and strictly enforced at all times. Signage with specific restrictions will be in place in all construction areas.
- Local access to businesses and residences will be maintained throughout all construction activities.
- Please obey all posted construction signs and do not enter the construction work zone.

(Construction schedules are subject to change for various reasons including but not limited to: weather conditions, unforeseen emergencies and other acts of nature.)
