



## SUPPLEMENTAL CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

### Venice Blvd Street Improvements

#### ATTENTION RESIDENTS AND BUSINESS OWNERS

As part of the construction of Phase 2 of the Expo Light Rail Line, work crews will implement lane and street closures to complete roadway improvements on Venice Blvd in the City of Los Angeles. The work is being managed and performed by the Expo Phase 2 design-build contractor *Skanska-Rados, Joint Venture (SRJV)*.

<b>Continuous Weekend Closure of Northbound Robertson Blvd North of Venice Blvd and the Eastbound I-10 Freeway Robertson Blvd Off-Ramp.</b>	24-Hour Work Shifts	9:00 p.m., Friday, January 23 6:00 a.m., Monday January 26
<b>Continuous Weekend Single Lane Reduction of Eastbound Venice Blvd and Northbound National Blvd</b>	24-Hour Work Shifts	9:00 a.m., Friday, January 30 - 6:00 a.m., Monday, February 2

**Traffic Impacts:**

- **Weekend of January 23-26: Closure of northbound Robertson Blvd:**
  - Local access to Northbound Robertson Blvd will be maintained via Ellis Ave and National Blvd. Please follow detour signs to loop around via Robertson Place to Exposition Blvd.
  - Eastbound I-10 Freeway Robertson Blvd Off-Ramp will be closed. Traffic will be detoured to the La Cienega freeway exit.
  - Only right turns will be allowed from Robertson Boulevard on to Venice Boulevard during this weekend closure.
- Additional intermittent nighttime lane closures will be implemented throughout construction.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times either via a designated pedestrian walkway or detour.

**Advisories:**

- Directional signage and/or flaggers will be used to safely direct vehicles and pedestrians around the construction zone.
- Temporary parking restrictions will be required and strictly enforced at all times. Signage with specific restrictions will be in place in all construction areas.
- Local access to businesses and residences will be maintained throughout all construction activities.
- Please obey all posted construction signs and do not enter the construction work zone.
